

Scottish Traditional Boat Festival 2010, 26th-27th June 2010, Portsoy, Banff

The Moray Gig, *Bien Trouvé*, attended the Scottish Traditional Boat Festival at Portsoy. Gary Hunt towed the gig there on 25th June and she was moored in the old 17th century harbour. Next day she was crewed by eleven young people from Moray, three of whom belong to the group of ten going to the Atlantic Challenge International Contest of Seamanship in Canada at the end of July. Her young crew at Portsoy won the Christine Thain Memorial Trophy for best turned out boat at the Festival. Evidently the committee vote was unanimous, and the trophy was for the professionalism of the crew as well the turn out of gig.
